

Product description

The T-ISS PX02 Hook is an automatic release hook for davit-launched liferafts, designed to handle a safe working load of 25 kN. It can function as an automatic release hook, activating when the raft enters the water, or as a manual release hook.

The PX02 meets high SOLAS standards for release hooks, as specified in MSC.81(70) and the applicable LSA code, and is suitable for davit-launched liferafts with a load up to 2,500 kg.

Installation

Disassemble the top shaft by removing the cotter pin and unscrewing the nut. Place the spliced eye or corresponding wire rope over the distance bush, position the distance bush between the two side plates, and reinsert the shaft. Ensure the shaft is fastened securely, and replace the cotter pin.

The PX02 can be set to automatic just before the raft reaches the water by pulling the cord (using the latch as a handle). Once the raft is waterborne, the hook opens automatically.

- Use a shackle \varnothing 19 mm up to \varnothing 27 mm
