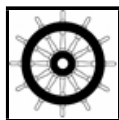

Product description

“YB-LT300 pneumatic line-throwing appliance”

is a line-throwing appliance with a launching system based on compressed air as driving force and with minimum shooting range of 230 m. The hand-held base firing unit has a built-in cylinder for compressed air up to 300 bars. The projectiles are made of ABS plastic with an aluminium alloy inner tube containing a 260 m long and 3 mm thick high strength polyethylene line. The breaking strength of the high strength polyethylene line is not less than 2000 N. The projectiles are reloadable and reusable.

Design weight: 8 kg.

Application/Limitation

Approved for use as Line-throwing appliances onboard ships.

The air cylinder shall be pressurized to maximum 300 bar.

The air cylinder shall be checked periodically according to user manual and have a hydrostatic test performed every 5 years from date of manufacture as written on the Declaration of Conformity for the launcher.

The line has no expiration date as long as it is stored in a dry place without direct sunlight.

To conform to the requirements of LSA Code Ch. 7.1.1, one Line-throwing Appliance must include not less than 4 projectiles.

The unit shall be stored in a dry and safe place when not in use.

The design assessment is based on LSA Code as amended by IMO Res. MSC.207(81) and IMO Res. MSC.218(82).

Each product is to be supplied with its manual for installation, use and maintenance.
